

Overview

- The **Trigger Management Module** is a powerful and effective feature to help Servicers automate loan covenant management
- Reduce your organization's exposure to risk in order to remain in compliance
- Improve efficiencies and reduce time spent managing covenants

Using Process for Triggers

- Using Process and Rules most Triggers can be easily tracked
 - Read Loan Docs for Covenants (Store a copy in Notes)
 - Use Rules to add Trigger events (e.g Lease Expiring, Pending Maturity)
 - Create Process to monitor Trigger event and remediate if necessary
 - 1) Review Rent Roll
 - 2)Resolve Tenant Expiration Differences
 - 3)Escalate non-renewal
 - ...
- So why use Trigger Management?

Trigger Management

- Regimented workflow/queues for each level of review
 - Manager Queue (Population)
 - Analyst Queue (Review)
 - Monitoring Queue
 - Escalation Queue
- Abstract provides enhanced functionality
 - Store complete Trigger verbiage from Loan Docs
 - Create Trigger Events by Category
 - Interim/Finalized
- Escalation
 - Event Escalation Worksheet
 - Approvals & Audit

Trigger Management (cont.)

- 3 Process/Task Queues
 - Trigger Manager
 - Trigger Analyst
 - Trigger Monitoring
- Trigger Abstract & Escalation widgets
- Hardcoded Job Functions for each Queue
- 48+ Events with defined Process Templates

Trigger Manager Widget

- New Loan Added Rule –or- Manual Start
 - Process "Portal Trigger Abstract"
 - Assigned to TIG Manager 1
 - Can complete the Abstract, or reassign to Analyst

Abstract

- User defined Trigger Events can be added with Processes
- Events are Categorized
 - Borrower/Property Performance, Tenant Related, Property Improvements or Reserve Requirements
- Frequency
 - Manual Start or regular Frequency
- Cash Management Waterfall
- Document Checklist

Trigger Monitoring

- Once Abstract is Finalized, Monitoring Process is started
 - Assigned by TMG WorkFlow TL1 or by Loan Set
- Started by one of 3 ways
 - Rules data condition starts Process
 - Date Driven Frequency from the Trigger Event screen
 - Manual Start

Escalating a Trigger Event

- Add Tasks to existing Monitoring Process (as needed)
 - PREPARE AN ACTION FORM
 - SUBMIT ACTION FORM AFTER APPROVAL
 - PREPARE ESCALATION
- Escalation Widget
 - Monitoring Analyst completes Escalation Worksheet
 - Asset Manager approves and Finalizes
 - Summary is provided

Reports

- Trigger Level Reports
 - Aging
 - Assignment
 - Escalation
 - End of Month
 - Production
- Both Abstract and Escalation widgets can be exported to Excel

Rule Events

- These Event Types are tied to Rules & Will start Automatically
 - Debt Yield Falls Below Threshold
 - DSCR Falls Below Threshold
 - Loan Not Paid Off At Maturity/ARD
 - Occupancy Rate Below Threshold
 - Poor Inspection Rating
 - Tenant Terminates Lease/Receives Payment
- Threshold Values defined on Trigger Actions screen

"Should I be using the Trigger Management Module?"

□ I have loan covenants – simple or complex

I have standard or a variation of loan covenants

□ I have a low or high volume of loan covenants

□ I need to improve management of compliance with ratings agencies and auditors
